Your Union bargaining committee continues to meet with Safeway with the intention of concluding a new Collective Agreement that addresses the concerns that you, the members, have put forward as your workplace priorities.

Over the past two negotiation sessions steady process has been made in dealing with the outstanding non-monetary proposals, however, numerous of your issues still require more discussions with your employer.

Members may be concerned that negotiations are dragging on, but, in order to address your proposals, your bargaining committee requires the time to have meaningful discussions on all of the proposals that are important to you, the hard working employees of Safeway.

On a positive note, the company has provided bargaining dates every month up to the end of the year which is a sign that perhaps, they want a negotiated settlement also.

Our next bargaining dates are in late August and further updates will be provided after that session.
