Union prepares charges at Labour Board Company Unfairly Influences Strike Vote!

But Old Dutch Employees still vote in favour of striking!

Calgary - The strike vote results are in, and they are solid. But they aren't as solid as they would have been had the company not interfered.

Union Lawyers will be filing charges at the *Alberta Labour Relations Board* alleging that the company and its buddies have intimidated people and misrepresented the facts, influencing strike vote results.

Even with that kind of bullying, NINETY-ONE (91) Old Dutch Employees voted to strike and over ONE HUNDRED (100) have registered for strike duty.

Fifty Employees would not yet authorize strike action.

The net result is that a strong majority of Old Dutch Employees have voted to strike and the union will ask the company to start to negotiate fairly!
